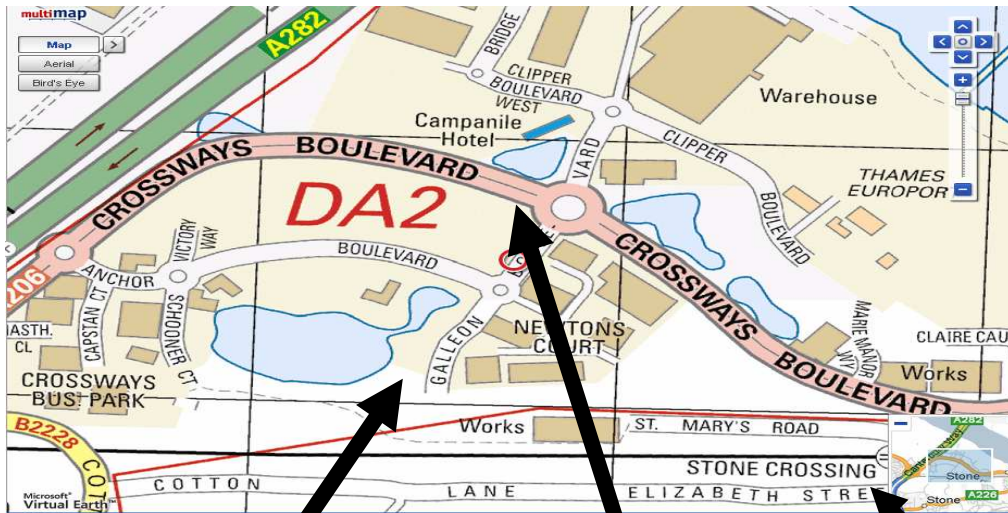


How to get to Mariner House by public transport

Mariner House is easily reached by public transport. We encourage visitors to take advantage of this as part of our green travel plan. If you have any mobility difficulties in using public transport please contact the person you are visiting at Moat

The stations detailed all have direct trains from London ([link to national rail](#)) Dartford and Greenhithe are serviced by the Fastrack bus service. ([link to fastrack here](#))

Buses run every five to ten minutes. There are bus stops directly outside both Greenhithe and Dartford stations (just down the steps at Dartford Station). The journey times are approximately three minutes from Greenhithe and ten minutes from Dartford Station.

Fastrack tickets cost £1.50 single/£2.50 return. You need to buy your ticket before you get on the bus, using the correct change, from one of the machines at the station or bus stop.

There is a taxi rank at Dartford Station.

- Stone Crossing: 0.5 miles. Trains approximately every 30 minutes from Charing Cross and London Bridge. Travel time 40 minutes. It is then a short walk along Crossways Boulevard to Mariner House.
- Dartford: 3.5 miles. Trains from Charing Cross and London Bridge every 15 minutes, London Victoria and Cannon Street every 30 minutes. Travel time 40 minutes. Then Fastrack route A towards Greenhithe.
- Greenhithe: -1.5 miles. Trains from Charing Cross and London Bridge every 15 minutes. Travel time 40 minutes. Then Fastrack route A towards Dartford Park.

When you leave the bus at the junction of Crossways and Galleon Boulevard, it is a short walk to Mariner House, (follow the signs for the Wharf Pub).
