

Energy efficient doors and windows



All homes lose heat through their windows and doors but energy efficient glazing is a way to keep your home warmer, quieter and reduce your energy bills.

Energy-efficient glazing is the term used to described double or triple glazing:

Double glazing – A window with two sheets of glass with a gap in between each sheet of glass.

Triple glazing – A window with three sheets of glass with a gap

between each sheet of glass.

Doors can also be draught proofed. Having properly fitted new external doors that are insulated and draught-proof would keep your home warmer and more energy efficient.

What are the benefits of having energy efficient doors and windows?

- Reduce energy bills
- Reduce carbon footprints
- Creates a more comfortable home. It will be warmer and quieter
- Reduced condensation.
 Upgrading your windows and doors can reduce condensation build up on the inside of the panes
